The attached form has been drafted to align with the Act and the Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct is much more exhaustive when identifying relationships that may pose a conflict of interest while the Act focuses more on pecuniary interests. Staff did reach out to the advisor for additional information as directed by the Board. Following approval Staff will appropriately brand the form and include it on the website.

Pecuniary Interest - an interest concerning or consisting of money, including an interest that has a monetary or financial value. A pecuniary interest can be positive or negative.

Direct Pecuniary Interest - A member has a direct pecuniary interest that has an impact on the individual's finances, including economic interest or property value

Indirect Pecuniary Interest - a member has an indirect pecuniary interest in any matter in which the council or local board, as the case may be, is concerned, if,

- (a) the member or his or her nominee,
 - (i) is a shareholder in, or a director or senior officer of, a corporation that does not offer its securities to the public,
 - (ii) has a controlling interest in or is a director or senior officer of, a corporation that offers its securities to the public, or
 - (iii) is a member of a body,

that has a pecuniary interest in the matter; or

(b) the member is a partner of a person or is in the employment of a person or body that has a pecuniary interest in the matter.

Deemed Pecuniary Interest - the pecuniary interest, direct or indirect, of a parent or the spouse or any child of the member shall, if known to the member, be deemed to be also the pecuniary interest of the member

Exceptions

- as user of public utility;
- entitlement to any service, subsidy, loan or benefit common to other persons
- purchase or ownership of debenture
- deposit with municipality
- interest property affected by *Drainage Act* works or local improvements
- interest in exempted farm lands

- regarding allowance, remuneration, salary or benefit for being a member
- interest in common with electors generally
- remote or insignificant interest

Conflict of Interest - a situation in which a member of an O.P.P. detachment board's private interests or personal relationships place, or may reasonably be perceived to place, the member in conflict with their duties as a member of the O.P.P. detachment board

Personal Relationship - includes, but is not limited to, a relationship with any of the following persons:

- 1. A current or former spouse or common-law partner of the board member.
- 2. A current or former intimate partner of the board member.
- 3. The board member's children, including biological and adoptive children and stepchildren.
- 4. The legal dependants of the board member.
- 5. A child in the board member's care.
- 6. The board member's grandparents, parents or siblings, including grandparents-in-law, parents-in-law and siblings-in-law. ("rapports personnels")
